

Summary of Available APMs

1) Bundled Payments for Care Improvement (BPCI) Initiative

Summary: The BPCI initiative is comprised of four broadly defined models of care, which link payments for the multiple services during an episode of care. Organizations enter into payment arrangements that include financial and performance accountability for episodes of care.

These models may lead to higher quality and more coordinated care at a lower cost to Medicare. If a participant manages to keep all aggregate costs for the episode below the target price, they receive a payment from CMS for a share of the savings. Participants also must maintain or improve quality outcomes to receive their full savings payment from CMS.

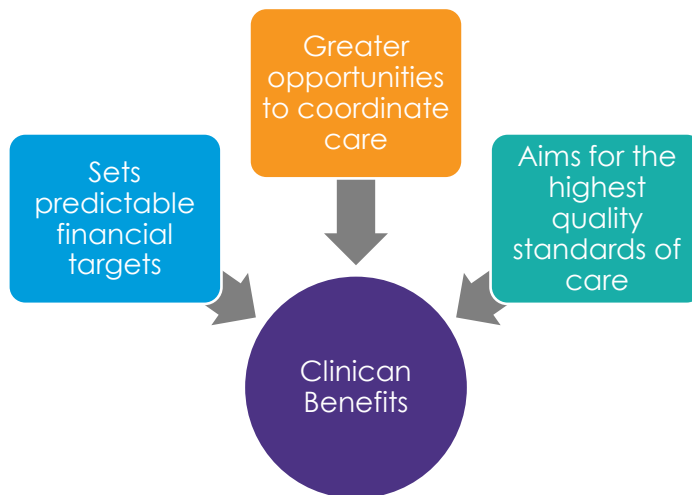

BCPI: Model 2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Expenditures reconciled against target price for an episode of care (hospital stay)
BCPI: Model 3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Expenditures reconciled against target price for an episode of care (hospital stay) • Medicare continues fee-for-service payments • Total expenditures later reconciled against bundled payment amount • Medicare payment reflects aggregate performance compared to target price

2) Next Generation ACO Model

Summary: Medicare ACOs are comprised of groups of doctors, hospitals, and other health care providers and suppliers who come together voluntarily to provide coordinated, high-quality care at lower costs. The Next Generation ACO Model allows provider groups to assume higher levels of financial risk and reward. Included in the Next Generation ACO Model are strong patient protections to ensure that patients have access to and receive high-quality care. Like other Medicare ACO initiatives, this Model will be evaluated on its ability to deliver better care for individuals, better health for populations, and lower growth in expenditures.

3) Comprehensive Primary Care Plus

Summary: A national advanced primary care medical home model that aims to strengthen primary care through regionally-based multi-payer payment reform and care delivery transformation. Giving providers the flexibility to make investments, improve quality of care and reduce unnecessary services.
