How Does it Affect My Medicare Payments?

Have you noticed a negative adjustment on your Medicare claims in 2020? It may be caused by lack of participation in the Quality Payment Program.

The adjustment in 2020 for the 2018 performance year is negative 5 percent. This will increase to negative 9 percent by 2022. You can avoid this by participating in the Quality Payment Program. You can participate in a variety of ways: collect information about quality measures performed during routine care, track activities that improve your clinical practice and/or promoting patient engagement and electronic exchange of information using your EHR.

How to Participate

YOU DO NOT NEED AN EHR TO PARTICIPATE

Quality: Report on various measures during routine patient care. Report your measures on Medicare claims, through a registry or qualified clinical data registry and/or using your EHR.

Improvement Activities: Activities that enhance clinical practice or care delivery. You may already be doing some of these as part of day-to-day operations.

Promoting Interoperability: You need an EHR to submit data for this category, however, as a small practice you may be able to file for an exception.

Cost: Cost Measures are calculated from Medicare Claims. You don't need to submit data.
